

REMINDER



THE CITY IS STILL UNDER STAGE 2 DROUGHT CONDITIONS

*While recent rains have been helpful to raise the lake level, the City of Granbury is STILL in a STAGE 2 drought condition. **WE ARE ASKING ALL WATER CUSTOMERS TO PLEASE CONTINUE TO CONSERVE WATER.***

ALERT – VIOLATORS SHALL BE FINED

- 1st Occurrence: Warning citation issued by Granbury Police Department
 - 2nd Occurrence: Warning citation issued by Granbury Police Department
 - 3rd and/or Subsequent Occurrences: You will receive a citation from the Granbury Police Department resulting in a **\$500** fine + a **\$100** administration fee added to your bill. (Disconnection also may occur. Services will be reconnected after a **\$60** reconnect fee is paid.)
- **Landscape watering** with an irrigation system, sprinkler or soaker hose is allowed **twice a week from 12 am -10 am and 8 pm -12 am** on your designated watering day, as determined by your address.
 - **Irrigation of landscaped areas** is permitted at anytime if it is by means of a hand-held hose, a faucet filled bucket or watering can of five (5) gallons or less, or drip irrigation system.
 - **Watering with a hand-held hose** is allowed any time on any day.
 - **Use of fountains, waterfalls,** or other aesthetic water features — outdoors or indoors — is prohibited, except where necessary to support aquatic life or where such fountains or ponds are equipped with a recirculation system.
 - **Use of water to fill,** refill, or add to any indoor or outdoor swimming pools, wading pools, or jacuzzi-type pools is prohibited except on designated watering days between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 10:00 am and between 8 pm and 12:00 midnight.
 - **Residential washing of vehicles** or other equipment is allowed only on assigned watering days and times. A hose with an automatic shut-off nozzle or bucket of five gallons or less may be used. Water should not be allowed to run into the street.
 - **The use of commercial car wash facilities** is allowed any day.

The use of treated wastewater or recycled water is a defense to prosecution under these rules. Stage 2 restrictions continue until there is an announcement in the newspaper that Stage 2 has been canceled or that Stage 3 is in effect.

Landscape watering with an irrigation system, sprinkler or soaker hose is allowed only twice a week, from 12 am - 10 am and 8 pm-12 am on your designated watering day

WATERING SCHEDULE

Last Digit of Street Address	Watering Day
EVEN	Sunday
ODD	Wednesday
EVEN	Thursday
ODD	Saturday

- All restrictions from Stage 1 remain in effect, unless added to or replaced by Stage 2 rules.
- The City of Granbury uses drought restrictions, established by city ordinance, to proactively manage the city's water resources.
- Stage 2 Restrictions begin when total daily water demand equals or exceeds 2.5 million gallons for 5 consecutive days or 3.1 million gallons on a single day.
