- **Guess the Candy Corn**: Guess the number of candy corn in the giant jar for a chance to win it. The winner of the candy corn jar will be announced at 2:40 p.m.

Parking for the event will be at the City of Granbury Service Center, Dana Vollmer Municipal Swim Center, and soccer field parking lots.
