		City Council review & approval (for FIA agreements AND plat if plat is submitted concurrently)
		Schedule Pre-construction meeting with Public Works Department and chosen contractor(s)
		Commence construction / installation of infrastructure improvements after 'Notice to Proceed' letter
		from Director of Public Works
		Inspection as required by Public Works
		Submit ½ size 'as-built' mylars & Exhibit H (from developer's engineer)
		2-year maintenance bond filed with Public Works
		After inspections are finalized, written letter of acceptance issued by Public Works
