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Scheduled Outage for City Online Portals, Phone Systems

Granbury, Texas – Several of City of Granbury’s online portals and the City buildings’ phone system will be offline for a scheduled outage beginning at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 30. Systems maintenance is planned to be finished by noon on Saturday, August 31.

Services that will be offline during this scheduled maintenance to the City computer network include:

- **Utility billing payments and court payments**

Customers can still make court and utility payments during the outage by dropping payments into the drop deposit boxes in front of City Hall (116 W. Bridge St.).

- **City phones systems**

This does not include 9-1-1, which will remain operational. Please always call 9-1-1 in the event of an emergency.

- **Inspections Portal**
