Granbury, Texas – The City of Granbury has hired JoAnne Milhollin Kamman as the new City Engineer for the Public Works Department. Kamman has 35 years of professional experience in engineering and construction management.

Professionally, she worked 27 years for the City of Houston Public Works Department, performing various functions of engineering and construction management for the city’s Capital Improvement Program. Kamman also served as the Engineering Manager for Storm Water Maintenance Section, and she created and managed the Interagency Group in the Public Works Department which provided an interface between various agencies (TxDOT, Metropolitan Transit Authority, Harris County, etc) and the City of Houston. After leaving Houston, she worked for two years at the City of Fort Worth as the Program Manager of the City’s Major Thoroughfare and Arterial Program.
